Meaning: DISPOSSESS: to take away someone's property, rights, or possessions, often by force or legal means.

1. The government decided to dispossess the landowners to make way for the new highway.
2. After the revolution, many wealthy families were dispossessed of their estates and assets.
3. The court ruled that the tenants could not be dispossessed without proper compensation.
4. Historical injustices often lead to modern discussions about how to rectify dispossession.
5. Dispossessing individuals of their rights can lead to widespread social unrest and conflict.
