Meaning: Disprovable: capable of being proven false or invalid through evidence or experimentation.

1. A theory is considered scientific only if it is disprovable through experimentation.
2. Many of the claims made in pseudoscience are not disprovable, which raises skepticism.
3. The philosopher argued that beliefs should be disprovable to be taken seriously.
4. In mathematics, axioms are often taken as truths that are not disprovable within the system.
5. The debate centered around whether the hypothesis was truly disprovable or merely untestable.
