

DISQUALIFY

Meaning: To disqualify means to declare someone ineligible to participate in a competition or receive an award due to a violation of rules or standards.

1. The athlete was disqualified from the competition due to a failed doping test.
2. Her failure to adhere to the guidelines will disqualify her from receiving the scholarship.
3. The referee decided to disqualify the team after they repeatedly broke the rules.
4. If you do not submit your application on time, it will disqualify you from the selection process.
5. The judge's decision to disqualify the entry was final and could not be appealed.
