Meaning: To disrank means to lower or remove someone from a position of rank or status within a hierarchy or organization.

1. The unexpected scandal caused her to disrank from her position within the organization.
2. After the competition, he was shocked to find that his performance had disranked him among his peers.
3. The committee decided to disrank several candidates due to their lack of necessary qualifications.
4. When the new evidence emerged, it led the authorities to disrank the previously favored suspects.
5. The recent changes in policy may disrank some teams in the upcoming evaluation process.
