Meaning: DISSERVICE: an action that causes harm or disadvantage to someone or something, often by failing to meet their needs or expectations.

1. The new policy did a disservice to the employees by cutting their benefits.
2. By ignoring the issue, the committee performed a disservice to the community it was meant to serve.
3. The misleading advertisement did a significant disservice to consumers seeking honest information.
4. He realized that his lack of communication had done a disservice to the team's collaboration efforts.
5. Sometimes, trying to help can inadvertently result in a disservice to those you aim to support.
