Meaning: DISSUADER (noun): A person or thing that discourages or prevents someone from taking a particular action or making a decision.

1. The presence of a strong dissuader can often prevent impulsive decisions.
2. Parents often serve as dissuaders when their children consider risky activities.
3. Effective communication can act as a powerful dissuader in heated arguments.
4. His stern warnings acted as a dissuader for anyone thinking about breaking the rules.
5. The campaign aimed to serve as a dissuader against the dangers of reckless driving.
