

# DISSYLLABIFICATION

*Meaning: DISSYLLABIFICATION: The linguistic process of reducing a word or syllable structure from three syllables to two, often occurring in rapid speech to simplify pronunciation.*

1. Dissyllabification often occurs in rapid speech as speakers simplify their pronunciation.
2. The process of dissyllabification can significantly alter the rhythm of spoken language.
3. Linguists study dissyllabification to understand how language evolves over time.

5. Teachers of phonetics emphasize the importance of recognizing dissyllabification in language learning.
