

DISTORT

Meaning: To distort means to twist or alter the shape, appearance, or meaning of something, often resulting in a misleading or exaggerated representation.

1. The funhouse mirrors distort our reflections, making us look taller or wider than we really are.
2. His attempt to distort the facts only made him appear less credible to the audience.
3. The artist chose to distort the landscape in her painting to evoke a sense of surrealism.
