

DISTRAINABLE

Meaning: Distainable refers to property or assets that can be seized or taken by a creditor to satisfy a debt or obligation.

1. The landlord informed the tenant that the unpaid rent was distainable under the lease agreement.
2. In cases of default, the bank has the right to seize distainable assets to recover its losses.
3. The lawyer explained that certain personal possessions are not distainable in bankruptcy proceedings.
4. After the judgment was passed, the court listed the distainable items that could be used to satisfy the debt.
5. It is crucial for creditors to understand which properties are distainable to effectively enforce their claims.
