Meaning: DISTRIBUTABLE (adjective): capable of being allocated or divided among recipients, typically referring to profits or funds that can be shared or distributed.

1. The profits from the investment are now fully distributable among the shareholders.
2. He explained that the funds were not yet distributable until the project reached completion.
3. The company's policy allows for distributable earnings to be reinvested in new initiatives.
4. After the audit, it was confirmed that all assets were distributable according to the agreement.
5. She was pleased to learn that her inheritance was now distributable without any legal complications.
