Meaning: To disvouch means to refute or deny the validity of a claim or accusation.

1. The lawyer sought to disvouch the claims made by the opposing party.
2. In her testimony, she attempted to disvouch the accusations that had been levied against her.
3. The committee found it difficult to disvouch the evidence presented by the whistleblower.
4. He issued a public statement to disvouch the rumors circulating about his involvement.
5. Despite her efforts to disvouch the allegations, the evidence seemed overwhelmingly against her.
