Meaning: Diuretic (adjective): relating to a substance that promotes the increased production of urine, often used to manage fluid retention.

1. The doctor prescribed a diuretical medication to help manage her fluid retention.
2. After reviewing the patient's symptoms, the nurse noted the need for a diuretical intervention.
3. Many herbal teas are believed to have diuretical properties that can promote urine flow.
