

DIURNALLY

Meaning: Diurnally: occurring or active during the daytime.

1. The flowers in the garden bloom diurnally, opening with the sunrise and closing at dusk.
2. Some animals exhibit diurnally active behaviors, foraging during the day while resting at night.
3. In tropical regions, temperatures can fluctuate diurnally, leading to cool evenings after hot days.

5. Many species of birds migrate diurnally, taking advantage of the daylight to navigate and forage.
