Meaning: DOCTRINALLY: In a manner relating to the principles, beliefs, or teachings of a particular doctrine or set of doctrines.

1. The church was doctrinally opposed to any form of modernism.
2. Her arguments were rooted in a doctrinally sound interpretation of scripture.
3. The group met regularly to discuss issues that were doctrinally significant to their beliefs.
4. He felt that the teachings were not only doctrinally accurate but also practical for everyday life.
