Meaning: Downstroke: a downward motion or stroke, particularly in calligraphy or music, that enhances emphasis or impact.

1. The artist emphasized the downstroke in her calligraphy to create a bold effect.
2. In music, the drummer's downstroke added a powerful beat to the song.
3. During the yoga class, the instructor demonstrated a downstroke to synchronize breathing with movement.
4. The designer recommended a downstroke technique for the graphic to enhance its visual appeal.
