

DOXOLOGIZE

Meaning: Doxologize: to express praise or glorification, typically in a formal or communal setting, often through singing or reciting a doxology.

1. The congregation would often doxologize at the end of the service, lifting their voices in praise.
2. During the wedding ceremony, the officiant invited everyone to doxologize, celebrating the union of the couple.
3. To doxologize effectively, the choir harmonized beautifully, creating an atmosphere of reverence.
4. In moments of deep gratitude, many people find themselves compelled to doxologize spontaneously.
5. The church tradition includes a moment where the pastor encourages the faithful to doxologize together.
