Meaning: To drape is to arrange or hang a piece of fabric loosely and elegantly over a surface or object.

1. The artist chose to drape the fabric over the statue to create a sense of mystery.
2. She skillfully draped the curtains, allowing just the right amount of light to filter in.
3. During the ceremony, the flag was draped over the podium in a solemn tribute.
4. The designer decided to drape the gown in layers for an elegant, flowing effect.
5. He draped his arm around her shoulders, offering comfort and support in that moment.
