

DRIFTPIN

Meaning: A driftpin is a tapered metal pin used to align or hold parts in place during assembly or repair work.

1. The mechanic used a driftpin to align the parts of the engine before fastening them together.
2. When assembling the frame, make sure to tap the driftpin gently to avoid damaging the material.
3. I found a rusted driftpin in the toolbox, a reminder of the many repairs I had undertaken over the years.
4. To ensure accuracy in the installation, he inserted the driftpin through the holes before tightening the screws.
5. Using a driftpin can simplify the process of fitting two pieces of metal without causing misalignment.
