

# DUCKS-FOOT

*Meaning: Ducks-foot refers to a type of aquatic plant characterized by leaves that resemble the shape of a duck's foot.*

1. The unique shape of the leaves resembles a duck's foot, which is how the plant got its name.
2. In the wetlands, the vibrant green of the ducks-foot plant creates a striking contrast against the dark water.
3. Birdwatchers often spot various species of ducks foraging near the banks where ducks-foot lushly grows.

5. During our nature walk, we noted the ducks-foot's distinctive lobed leaves among the other aquatic vegetation.
