

ECHIDNA

Meaning: Echidna: a spiny, egg-laying mammal of the family Tachyglossidae, native to Australia and New Guinea, known for its long snout and diet primarily consisting of ants and termites.

1. The echidna is one of only five existing species of monotremes, which lay eggs instead of giving birth to live young.
