Meaning: Eclaircise: to make a complex concept clearer or easier to understand through explanation or illustration.

1. Eclaircise is often used in discussions about clarifying complex concepts.
2. In an effort to eclaircise his point, he provided several detailed examples.
3. The teacher aimed to eclaircise the instructions for the assignment to avoid confusion.
4. During the meeting, she took the time to eclaircise the new policy changes.
5. To eclaircise the process, he created a step-by-step guide for the team.
