Meaning: Eductive: relating to a method of reasoning or teaching that involves drawing out knowledge or conclusions from evidence or observations.

1. The teacher employed an eductive approach, encouraging students to derive conclusions from their own observations.
2. Through eductive reasoning, the detective pieced together the clues left at the crime scene.
3. Her eductive skills allowed her to connect seemingly unrelated concepts in a profound way.
4. In a debate, he used eductive arguments to guide the audience to his perspective without directly stating it.
5. The workshop focused on eductive techniques that helped participants discover their own insights rather than just absorbing information.
