

EFFLATE

Meaning: Efflate: to inflate or expand something, such as a balloon or sample, typically by introducing air or gas.

1. The technician will efflate the balloon slowly to ensure it maintains its shape.
2. During the experiment, the researchers decided to efflate the sample to observe the changes in pressure.
3. To prepare for the flight, they needed to efflate the inflatable safety equipment on board.
