Meaning: Efform (verb): to create or establish something, particularly a group or strategy, in response to a specific need or purpose.

1. The committee decided to efform a new subcommittee to tackle the issue.
2. In order to stay relevant, the organization needs to efform its strategies for outreach.
3. They will efform a plan that addresses both immediate concerns and long-term goals.
4. As the project progressed, it became clear they needed to efform their approach to better meet client expectations.
