Meaning: 'Either' is used to indicate a choice between two alternatives or options.

1. You can choose either tea or coffee for your breakfast.
2. I haven't decided whether to go to the beach or stay home; either option sounds appealing.
3. She will either call you back later or send you a text message.
4. You can either take the bus or walk, depending on your mood.
5. The weather forecast predicts either rain or sunshine for the weekend.
6. You can choose either the red dress or the blue one for the party.
7. I didn't like either of the movies we watched last night.
8. Either you finish your homework now, or you won't be able to play later.
9. She can either join us for dinner or meet us afterward for dessert.
10. The instructions are confusing; you can either follow them step by step or watch the tutorial video.
