*Meaning: EJECT: to force or throw out something or someone from a place or position.*

1. The player was ejected from the game for unsportsmanlike conduct.
2. The DVD player will automatically eject the disc after it finishes playing.
3. During the emergency drill, the pilot had to eject from the aircraft.
4. She felt a sense of relief as the toxic thoughts began to eject from her mind.
5. The machine is designed to eject the tray when the cycle is complete.
