

# EJECTMENT

*Meaning: EJECTMENT: A legal process by which a landlord seeks to remove a tenant from rental property due to violations of the lease agreement, such as non-payment of rent.*

1. The landlord filed for ejectment after the tenant failed to pay rent for several months.
2. Ejectment proceedings can be lengthy and often require legal representation.
3. In some cases, the court may grant a stay of ejectment to allow the tenant time to move.
4. The concept of ejectment is frequently misunderstood by those unfamiliar with property law.
5. After the ruling, the former occupant was given a strict timeline for ejectment from the premises.
