

ELIDE

Meaning: To elide means to omit or suppress a sound, syllable, or phrase in speech or writing.

1. The poet chose to elide certain phrases to maintain the rhythm of the verse.
2. In casual conversation, we often elide syllables, making words easier to say.
3. The editor decided to elide the lengthy explanation, focusing instead on the main argument.
4. When reading aloud, it can be tempting to elide difficult words for the sake of fluency.
5. In the final draft, she opted to elide redundant points to streamline the narrative.
