Meaning: In a manner that meets the necessary criteria or qualifications for selection or participation.

1. She was able to apply for the scholarship since she had graduated from college eligibly.
2. The program was designed to ensure that all participants were selected eligibly based on their qualifications.
3. To be considered for the job, candidates must apply eligibly within the specified timeframe.
4. His years of experience in the field made him eligibly suited for the senior management position.
5. The committee reviewed the applications to confirm that all applicants had met the eligibly criteria.
