

EMBARGE

Meaning: Embargo: a government order that restricts or prohibits trade or commerce with a specific country or the exchange of specific goods.

1. The government decided to impose an embargo on the export of certain materials to protect national interests.
2. After years of diplomatic tensions, the United Nations finally lifted the embargo on trade with the country.
3. Activists argued that the embargo hurt ordinary citizens more than the intended political leaders.
