

EMBASTARDIZE

Meaning: EMBASTARDIZE (verb): to degrade or corrupt something by altering it in a way that diminishes its quality, authenticity, or integrity.

1. The constant revisions seemed to embastardize the original manuscript, stripping it of its artistic integrity.
2. Many critics argue that commercial pressures can embastardize the authentic voice of an artist.
3. In an attempt to appeal to a broader audience, the filmmakers embastardized the source material, much to the dismay of fans.
4. The professor warned that excessive edits could embastardize the quality of the students' work.
5. By diluting the message with excessive jargon, the report may embastardize the important findings it seeks to convey.
