

EMBOLUS

Meaning: Embolus: a blood clot or other substance that travels through the bloodstream and can cause a blockage in blood vessels.

1. An embolus can travel through the bloodstream and cause a blockage in vital organs.
2. The doctor explained that a blood clot can become an embolus if it dislodges from its original site.
3. In some cases, an embolus may originate from fat tissue following a fracture, complicating the patient's recovery.
