Meaning: EMBOWELMENT: the act of removing or exposing the internal contents or essence of something, often revealing hidden truths or significant changes.

1. The embowelment of the historical manuscript revealed secrets long buried in time.
2. In the graphic novel, the protagonist faced the embowelment of his enemy as a dramatic turning point.
3. The surgeon explained the risks involved in the embowelment procedure to the concerned family members.
4. Literary critics often discuss the symbolism of embowelment in the context of the novel's themes of sacrifice.
