Meaning: To embrue means to stain or imbue with a quality, often in a way that evokes strong emotions or moral implications.

1. The artist chose to embrue her canvas with vivid colors that evoked deep emotions.
2. In his quest for justice, he refused to let himself embrue his conscience with anger.
3. The storm seemed to embrue the landscape, leaving everything coated in a layer of mud and debris.
4. She felt the need to embrue her words with honesty, even if it meant hurting someone she cared about.
5. The poets often explore themes that embrue the human experience with both beauty and sorrow.
