Meaning: ENCAVE (verb): To enclose or embed something within a surrounding structure or material, often creating a hidden or protected space.

1. The ancient ruins were encaved within the steep cliffs, hidden from the outside world.
2. As the artist began to encave the sculpture, the details of the figure emerged beautifully.
3. The cave's entrance was encaved by thick vines, creating a natural barrier.
4. In her dreams, she often found herself in an encaved chamber filled with glittering treasures.
5. The geological survey revealed that the rock formations were encaved by centuries of erosion.
