

ENCHONDROMA

Meaning: An enchondroma is a benign tumor that develops within the cartilage of bones.

1. An enchondroma is a benign tumor that typically arises in the cartilage of bones.
2. Radiologists often identify an enchondroma on X-rays as a well-defined, lytic lesion.
3. While most enchondromas require no treatment, some may occasionally lead to pain or fractures.
4. The diagnosis of an enchondroma is usually confirmed through a combination of imaging studies and biopsy.
5. Patients with multiple enchondromas may be at higher risk for developing malignancies, necessitating regular monitoring.

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
