Meaning: Enclosure: a defined area, often surrounded by a barrier, used for a specific purpose such as a garden or public space.

1. The garden's enclosure was marked by a low stone wall covered in climbing ivy.
2. During the meeting, the architect presented his design for a new public enclosure at the park.
3. The wildlife sanctuary was designed with an enclosure that mimicked the animals' natural habitats.
4. As the storm approached, they hurried to secure the outdoor furniture within the enclosure.
