

ENCRUST

Meaning: To encrust means to cover or coat a surface with a hard layer or deposit, often forming a crust-like appearance.

1. The cave walls were encrusted with glimmering crystals that reflected the light beautifully.
2. Over time, barnacles encrust the hull of the boat, making it less efficient in the water.
3. The artist chose to encrust the sculpture with colorful glass shards for added texture and depth.
4. The archaeologists discovered a fossil encrusted in sediment, revealing insights into ancient life.
5. A thick layer of salt encrusted the rim of the glass, enhancing the cocktail's presentation and flavor.
