

ENCURTAIN

Meaning: To encurtain means to envelop or obscure something with a curtain-like effect, often creating an atmosphere of mystery or transformation.

1. The artist decided to encurtain the exhibition, adding an air of mystery to each piece.
2. As the sun set, the shadows began to encurtain the landscape, transforming it into a dreamlike scene.
3. To heighten the dramatic effect, she chose to encurtain the stage just before the final act.
4. The dense fog seemed to encurtain the village, making it feel like a scene from a fairy tale.
5. During the ceremony, they decided to encurtain the main event to build anticipation among the guests.
