

ENCYSTED

Meaning: Encysted refers to being enclosed in a protective capsule or cyst, often to survive unfavorable conditions or evade detection by the immune system.

1. The parasite remained encysted within the host's tissues, evading the immune response.
2. During the examination, the biologist discovered that the larvae were encysted in the sediment.
3. After a period of dormancy, the encysted bacteria resumed active growth when conditions improved.
4. In harsh environments, some organisms can become encysted to survive until conditions are favorable.
5. The encysted stage of the organism is crucial for its survival during unfavorable environmental conditions.
