

ENDOCARP

Meaning: Endocarp: the innermost layer of a fruit's pericarp that typically surrounds and protects the seed.

1. The endocarp of a peach is the hard shell that surrounds the pit.
2. In botany, the endocarp is crucial for understanding fruit structure and classification.
3. Coconut water is found within the fibrous husk, while the endocarp protects the seed inside.
4. Some fruits, like cherries, have a thin endocarp that is easily removed when the fruit is eaten.
5. The development of the endocarp can greatly influence the dispersal mechanisms of various plant species.
