

ENHARMONICALLY

Meaning: Enharmonically refers to the relationship between two musical notes that are perceived as the same pitch but are notated differently.

1. The two notes are enharmonically equivalent, meaning they sound the same despite being written differently.
2. In music theory, enharmonically related notes can create fascinating harmonic possibilities.
3. The composer skillfully used enharmonically altered notes to add depth to the melody.
