Meaning: Enoint means to apply oil or anointing fluid, often for a ceremonial or religious purpose.

1. The priest will enoint the congregation with holy oil during the ceremony.
2. Before the healing ritual, the shaman carefully prepares the herbs to enoint the sick.
3. In ancient traditions, it was customary to enoint the newborns to bless their future.
4. She decided to enoint herself with scented oil to enhance her meditation practice.
5. During the rites, the leader will enoint the chosen ones to signify their new roles.
