

ENSILE

Meaning: To ensile means to store and preserve green fodder, such as corn, in a silo or airtight container to promote fermentation and prevent spoilage.

1. Farmers often choose to ensile their corn to preserve it for winter feed.
2. The process of ensiling requires careful attention to moisture content to ensure optimal fermentation.
3. To maximize nutritional value, many dairy farmers ensile their alfalfa shortly after harvest.
