Meaning: Enterolith: a mineralized mass formed in the intestines, typically from undigested food, that can cause digestive obstructions, particularly in animals like horses.

1. An enterolith can form in the intestines when undigested food material accumulates.
2. Veterinarians often encounter enteroliths in horses, where they can lead to serious digestive issues.
3. The presence of an enterolith may require surgical intervention to prevent intestinal obstruction.
4. In some cases, enteroliths can be mistaken for tumors during medical imaging procedures.
5. Dietary changes may help reduce the risk of enterolith formation in susceptible animals.

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
