Meaning: Entoptic refers to visual phenomena that originate from within the eye, such as bright spots or flashes of light seen in one's vision.

1. The entoptic phenomena often manifest as bright spots or flashes of light in one's vision.
2. Researchers study entoptic effects to better understand the visual system's internal processes.
3. During the experiment, participants reported various entoptic sensations when exposed to specific stimuli.
