

ENVOY

Meaning: Envoy: a representative or messenger, often appointed to conduct diplomatic negotiations or convey messages on behalf of an authority.

1. The government appointed a special envoy to negotiate peace talks.
2. As the envoy of the queen, he carried a message of goodwill to the neighboring kingdom.
3. The United Nations envoy arrived in the war-torn region to assess the situation.
4. Her role as an envoy required her to navigate complex diplomatic relationships.
5. The ambassador served as the envoy to promote trade agreements between the two nations.

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
