

EPANORTHOSIS

Meaning: Epanorthosis is a rhetorical device in which a speaker or writer retracts a statement and replaces it with a stronger or more accurate one for emphasis or clarification.

1. The concept of epanorthosis can be seen in literature when a character corrects themselves for emphasis.
2. In her speech, she employed epanorthosis to clarify her thoughts and strengthen her argument.
3. The poet's use of epanorthosis added depth to the emotional resonance of the stanza.
4. Epanorthosis often serves to refine a statement, making it more impactful for the audience.
5. By utilizing epanorthosis, the speaker effectively drew attention to the importance of her main point.

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
