

EPIBOLIC

Meaning: EPIBOLIC: relating to a rhetorical technique that emphasizes a point by repeating or elaborating on it in a layered or cumulative manner.

1. The poet employed an epibolic structure to emphasize the emotional weight of his verses.
2. In her presentation, she used an epibolic technique to drive home the central theme repeatedly.
3. The novel's epibolic style added layers of meaning, encouraging readers to reflect deeply on each passage.
4. His speech was characterized by epibolic repetition, which helped to reinforce his main arguments.
5. The artist's painting featured an epibolic composition that drew the viewer's eye in a circular motion.

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
