

EPICENTRAL

Meaning: Epicentral refers to the area on the Earth's surface directly above the point where an earthquake originates, typically experiencing the greatest shaking and damage.

1. The epicentral region of the earthquake experienced the most intense shaking and damage.
2. Seismologists are particularly interested in the epicentral coordinates to assess the quake's impact.
3. After the epicentral event, the community rallied together to provide support and recovery efforts.
4. The research team deployed sensors along the epicentral fault line to monitor future activity.
5. Local officials issued safety warnings for residents living in the epicentral area due to aftershocks.
